**Set Up Crew:** Be the helpful hands that make the magic happen! The Set Up Crew gets to see and help make the festival come to life by working closely with the New Belgium Carneys to put the final touches on the festival tents, banners, signs, flags, and so much more. Set Up Crew Volunteers must be able to volunteer on Friday, May 29<sup>th</sup> from 1-3pm and must be available during that whole time.

**WABA Brigade Volunteers:** Secretly, we love these volunteers the most. If you are friendly, love bicycles, and love WABA, this is the volunteer opportunity for you!

**Dress Rehearsal Beer Booth:** Because the DC Tour de Fat is the first of the 2015 season, New Belgium essentially throws a party before the party! Friday, May 29<sup>th</sup> is a "dress rehearsal" for the actual Tour de Fat and we will be on site at the Beer Booth selling beer to Yards Park Friday Night Concert attendees. This shift if Friday, May 29<sup>th</sup> from 5:30-8:30pm. Must be 21 or older.

**Bike Ride Registration:** What's a bicycle festival without a bike ride?! The day kicks off with a huge bicycle ride and we need your help getting folks ready for the ride! The Bike is technically free, but we really hope everyone will donate \$5 to the cause (which is WABA and other bike NPOs!), so you'll smooze the crowd trying to get folks to donate and join in for the ride. We anticipate over 300 people for the ride! You are highly encouraged to join us for the short bike parade from 11am-Noon – it'll be a blast.

**Beer Tokens:** Tour de Fat raises a tremendous amount of money for WABA and other bike non-profits and does so through beer sales. Beer Tokens volunteers are our money money makers! If you enjoy smiling and interacting with wacky people, this is for you. Here you will sell beer tokens (the coveted thing of the day! The holy grail!) to festival attendees. People will be lining up just for you!

**Hospitality:** This is truly one of the most fun shifts there is! You could get to be a Tour de Fat know-it-all and lend a hand at the Info Booth to answer attendees questions; smooze with VIPs at the VIP Lounge area while helping to ensure these Important People have a great experience; or entertain the little ones while helping in the Kids Area.
